*Here are the requirements for the
Wagon Wheel Flowers Quilt:*

FABRICS NEEDED to make the 64" x 84" quilt:

$\frac{1}{4}$ metre each of eight fabrics for flower petals -

I used eight fabrics from orange to yellow

$\frac{1}{4}$ metre of fabric for flower centres - I used a red print

$\frac{1}{4}$ metre each of six fabrics for "sky" - I used six blues ranging from light to dark

$\frac{1}{4}$ metre each of three fabrics for "ground" - I used three browns medium to dark

$\frac{1}{2}$ metre each of four fabrics for "leaves" -

I used two medium/light and two med/dark green fabrics

$\frac{1}{4}$ metre fabric for "stalks" - I used a very dark green fabric

$\frac{1}{4}$ metre fabric for narrow contrast border - I used chartreuse

1 $\frac{1}{4}$ metres of a dark border fabric - I used a brown/black print *

$\frac{3}{4}$ metre of fabric for binding the quilt - I used same red print as the flower centres*

3 $\frac{3}{4}$ metres of backing fabric*



OTHER ITEMS NEEDED:

- Sewing machine in good working order capable of doing a zig-zag stitch
- $\frac{1}{4}$ " piecing foot and open-toed or clear foot for your machine
- Invisible thread and regular sewing thread in neutral colour
- Freezer paper
- Pritt stick or water-soluble basting glue stick
- Rotary cutting equipment
- Iron
- Single sized wadding*
- Scissors, pins, etc.

NOTE: Items marked * will not be needed on the day of the class, but will be needed to complete the quilt.

All fabrics should be 100% dressweight cotton, and should be washed and ironed prior to class if possible. It will be more "fabric efficient" if you get full-width "long" quarter metres rather than fat quarters. Looking forward to seeing you in class!
