Here are the requirements for the WOVEN FAN quilt.



Materials to make the 63"x82" (eighteen 12" x 12" "on-point" blocks) quilt:

FABRIC:

- 1 ¼ metres of background fabric 1 – grey in the sample*
- 1 metre of background fabric 2 – taupe in the sample*
- 1 ¼ metres of fan fabric 1 for body of fan – medium scale oriental print*
- 1 ¼ metres of fan fabric 2 for body of fan – small scale oriental print*
- 1 ½ metres of fan fabric 3 for top curved arc and base square of fan large scale oriental print in the sample*
- ¾ metres each of two fabrics for setting triangles - two tones of beige
- 1 ¼ metres of fabric for 1st border and binding**
- 3 ½ metres of backing fabric**

OTHER:

- Sewing machine in good working order capable of zig-zag
- ¼" piecing foot and open-toed or clear foot for your machine
- Invisible thread and regular sewing thread in neutral colour
- Freezer paper
- Pritt stick or water-soluble basting glue stick
- Rotary cutting equipment
- Single sized wadding**
- Scissors, pins, etc.

*NOTE: if you'd like your quilt to be "scrappy" like the sample simply have fat quarters to add up to the yardage requirements for the quilt. If you want to make the quilt bigger you will need to make 7 additional blocks, which means getting an extra ½ metre of each of the fabrics for the top of the quilt and 5 metres for the backing.

** NOTE: These fabrics and items will not be needed in class, but you will need them to complete the quilt.

All fabric should be 100% dressweight cotton and should be washed and ironed prior to class if possible.
